A National Symposium on "Towards a Technology-based ELT in Higher Education" Abderrahmane Mira University of Bejaia July, 1st and 2nd, 2012

The national symposium about ELT in Algeria aims to help break academic boundaries and set worldwide pedagogical connections within higher education and with the reforms that where English is taught as a foreign language (EFL). In addition, we aim at building and reinforcing the link between theory and practice, approaches and methodologies - by providing a forum for discussing what ELT is becoming in Algeria after the reforms which have been launched at the higher education level. Such reforms highlight strongly the use of technology in all fields and EFL is one that needs implementing and using technology to follow the gist of international methods of teaching.

The conference should, therefore, be an opportunity for all participants, to exchange their views, experiences, understand research community concepts, context and mediation, and propose appropriate teaching strategies based on computer-mediated language learning. This can hopefully occur only if the outcomes of TEFL in Algeria are analyzed together with an overall evaluation of the reforms undertaken at all the stages of the Algerian higher educational system.

The idea to organize this national meeting where EFL teachers and professionals in ELT are warmly welcomed came after observing that our learners are still unable to master the language, are not engaged in electronic learning and our ELT is still unable to generalize the use of technology.
